- Do I have to stay on Campus?
 - o You can make alternative accommodation plans at your own cost.
 - o You will be responsible for travel to and from the workshop venue.
 - o You are responsible for booking your alternate accommodation

- Will the London members provide boarding / billeting for visiting members?
 - o No. The London volunteers are helping with workshop administration.
 - o The program is designed to offer affordable accommodation in the same location meals are being provided and where the workshop practice space is located.
- Where will we be sleeping / staying at the Fanshawe Campus / conference centre?
 - o The rooms are arranged in a shared suite configuration
 - o These are the student residences that not in use during the summer
 - o 4 individual bedrooms
 - Each bedroom has a privacy electronic lock with a double bed
 - Includes towels, all bedding, shampoo, soap, etc.
 - o 2 bathrooms (shared) – three piece (sink, toilet, tub/shower)
 - o Common area (shared) with seating and cable TV
 - o Kitchenette in the common area (fridge, microwave)

- What is included in the suite?
 - o Cable television
 - o High-speed Internet access
 - o Local telephone calls are complimentary (no phones in the room)
 - o Suites are **not** supplied with pots, pans, dishware or any utensils.

- Laundry facilities are available throughout the building (need a swipe card from the front desk).
 - A common kitchen area is accessible on the main floor featuring full sized stove-top ovens.
 - Light housekeeping service provided daily and full housekeeping (change linens) will be provided every fourth day
- Are the rooms air conditioned?
 - Yes. All of the residence buildings are air conditioned.
- What are the check-in / check-out times?
 - **Check-In Time: 3 PM** – scheduled date of arrival
 - **Check-Out Time: 11 AM** – scheduled date of departure
 - You can store any personal items in the Alumni Lounge during the workshop if you have to vacate your room or if you are waiting for your room to become available
- Can I request a two-bedroom suite?
 - There are two-bedroom suites available that are being assigned only under special circumstances.
- Are there any accessible suites?
 - Yes. There are a limited number of accessible suites available.
 - Please let the workshop organizers know if you require an accessible suite.
 - There are accessible washrooms available throughout the campus.
- Can I lock my room? What if I lose my key?
 - Each bedroom has an electronic lock.
 - The electronic key is similar to what hotels use.
 - The front desk at Peregrine House can help anyone with lock issues
- Do I have any choice of who I share a suite with?
 - You can request an all-female suite
 - You can request an all-male suite
 - You can arrange to stay with three of your friends to share a four bedroom suite together
- Can I share a room with someone else?
 - All bedrooms have a single double bed. Only one person will be assigned to a bedroom.
 - You can request that your room is in a quad where your friend(s) are also assigned to stay
- Do I need to tip?
 - The gratuity for your accommodation (and meals) is included in your workshop fee.

- Will there be room cleaning during the workshop?
 - o Any problems you have with your room can be brought to the attention of the front desk at Merlin House
 - o Full housekeeping (change linens) will be provided every fourth day
- How do I request fresh towels?
 - o You can request additional towels from the front desk
- Who do I speak to if there is an issue with the common area, bathroom or bedroom?
 - o Bring any concerns with your room, bathroom or common area (kitchenette) to the front desk.
- Can I bring my pet?
 - o Only service animals are permitted in the residence and campus buildings.
 - o Please notify the workshop organizers if you are bringing a service animal.
- When would I need to pay an extra fee for accommodation?
 - o When you register, you will receive a fee schedule that will indicate which nights are included in the workshop and which must be paid for separately
