- The possible transportation options to travel to London (all prices estimate in \$CAD) are:
 1. Car
 - a. If you are using the campus accommodation
 - i. Parking is complimentary for overnight parking
 - ii. Passes available when you check-in
 - b. If you are **not** using the campus accommodation
 - i. Parking is available for \$5.25/entry in the General Parking **Lot 7**.
 - ii. Parking is complimentary after 5:00 pm on Friday and all day on Saturday & Sunday
 - c. If you park at a meter: cost is \$3.25/hour

- Do I need Health Insurance and/or Travel Insurance?

- o If you are a resident of Ontario, you have full medical coverage while in London
- o If you required medical care in London, and you are a resident from outside of Ontario, you need to verify with your province what coverage is provided and if additional insurance is recommended
- o If you are visiting London from another country, it is highly recommended to have medical and travel insurance

- Is anyone arranging for transportation such as carpooling?

- o Each person is responsible for their own travel plans
- o Each Central Region location may be organizing car(s) to drive to the workshop(s)

- Central Region Instructors may apply for a travel subsidy to attend the Instructor Training Week
- Can I rent a car at the airport (or elsewhere)?
 - You are responsible for your transportation planning and costs
 - The rental agencies at the London airport include:
 - Alamo / National Car Rental (www.nationalcar.ca)
 - Avis / Budget (www.avis.ca)
 - Enterprise (www.enterprise.ca)
- My flight arrives / departs from Toronto (Pearson), how do I get to or from London?
 - There are numerous options from Pearson (see travel options for contact information for each option)
 - There are connecting flights to London.
 - You can take the ViaRail train to London (GoTransit connector)
 - You can take a bus to London (FlixBus and others)
 - You can take the Airport Shuttle (RobertQ) to London
- My flight arrives / departs from Detroit, how do I get to or from London?
 - There are numerous options from Detroit (see travel options for contact information for each option)
 - You can take the Airport Shuttle (RobertQ) to London
 - You can take the ViaRail train to London (connector to be determined)
 - You can take a bus to London (FlixBus and others)
 - Note: You will need to go through Canadian customs. You may need the address of the college where you are staying.
- How do I get from the London airport (or train station or bus station) to the college?
 - The workshop organizers have volunteer drivers that will shuttle members to Fanshawe College.
 - Workshop organizers will contact you to arrange pick-up and drop-off at the London International Airport, London Via Station or London area bus depot. Please include your anticipated arrival and departure times and dates with your registration form(s).
 - The alternative is to use the available London car service companies (see Car Services)
- Can I arrive before the start of the workshop (my travel plans / flight is the day before the start of the program)?
 - Yes. There may be a charge for the extra night stay and any extra meals
- Can I stay past the end of the workshop (my travel plans / flight is the day after the end of the program)?
 - Yes. There may be a charge for the extra night stay and any extra meals
