- Where is the Fanshawe campus?

 - o Note: There are multiple campus locations for Fanshawe College.
 - o The workshop is held at the main campus (Oxford Street and Highbury Avenue is the closest major intersection).
- How do I find Merlin House on the campus?
 - o There will be signs providing directions to Merlin House.
 - o Look for signs with the CTCA logo.
 - o Merlin House is the residence building on campus that will be providing the accommodation for everyone staying on campus
 - o Look for “R2” on the map – North West – Red Circle

- Where is the registration / information desk?
 - o The Alumni Lounge will have the registration desk.
 - o Located on the second floor of the Student Centre (Fanshawe Student Union Building / “J” Building) – capacity of 70 people
 - o The registration desk is staffed by CTCA volunteers

- Where do I go when I arrive (check-in)?
 - o Follow the campus signage / directions to the Student Centre (SC on the map)
 - o Greeters will be present to provide directions to the registration desk (Alumni Lounge)
 - o Merlin House front desk will direct you to the workshop registration desk
- What buildings will the workshop be using?
 - o The main Gymnasium will be the main workshop instruction venue
 - o Cafeteria – Oasis Dining Hall (main floor in the Fanshawe Student Union Building)
 - o Residence Building – Merlin House (R2 on the map)

- What practice space will the workshop be using?
 - o We are using the gymnasiums in the Student Centre (Fanshawe Student Union Building / "J" Building)
 - o Please wear clean indoor shoes in the gym
 - o Only sealed water bottles can be brought into the gym
 - o The instructors will be using an audio system
 - o For some workshop activities there may be other rooms in use (breakout rooms)
- Where is the lecture theatre?
 - o Tiered seating with full audio / visual supports
 - o Capacity of 100 people
- Where are the water refill stations on Campus?

- Other services available on campus?
 - o A list of available services will be available from the front desk on Peregrine House
 - o Some of the services that may be open include:
 - Coffee shop (CDs Coffee Bar, Starbucks)
 - Pub (Out Back Shack) *licensed
 - Workout Room
 - Pharmacy
 - Print Shop
 - Variety Store (The Nest)
 - Booster Juice
 - ATM
 - *Not included in the workshop fees – you will need to pay for any additional services
- Is there Parking available on campus?
 - o If you are using the campus accommodation option (Peregrine House)
 - Parking is complimentary (Lot 7)
 - Passes available when you check-in
 - o If you are **not** using the campus accommodation
 - Parking is available for \$5.25/entry in the General Parking Lot 8.
 - Parking is complimentary after 5:00pm on Friday and all day on Saturday & Sunday
 - Metered Parking is also available

- Is there access to laundry services on campus?
 - o Laundry facilities are available on the first floor of Merlin House Residence
 - o There are swipe cards available at the front desk and can be reloaded in the machine located in the laundry room
 - o You can purchase laundry supplies from the Merlin House front desk
- Will I be able to use the campus Wi-Fi?
 - o Yes. The welcome package will have instructions on how to connect to the Campus wide Wi-Fi
 - o There are no phones within the rooms, there is complimentary Wi-Fi available for everyone
- Are there places to rest?
 - o There are sitting areas in the main buildings as well as the residence
 - o Your room is within a short walk from the venue that you can use at any time to rest
- Are there places to meet with friends?
 - o Your room has a common sitting area shared by the four occupants of the suite. Please be considerate of your room mates if they are resting when using the common seating area
 - o Each floor of Merlin Hall has sitting areas
 - o Another option for a meeting is the sitting area in the common space in the Hospitality Suite.
- Are there plans for a Tai Chi Week in 2027?
 - o Yes. The next host location options are being investigated
- Will the Tai Chi weeks always be in the Central Region?
 - o The plan is to use the college conference services network which provides similar facilities and services at other colleges in Canada

- Is the workshop venue accessible?
 - o Yes. All buildings on campus meet accessibility requirements.
- Can I leave my personal belongings in the gymnasium?
 - o No. You should not leave any belongings in the gymnasium.
 - o Please take your property with you when you leave the gymnasium
 - o The gymnasium will be 'unlocked' and not monitored during meals and snack breaks
- Will the gymnasium be available for use before or after the workshop?
 - o You can use the gymnasium from 8:30 AM to 6:00 PM on most days.
 - o There is practice space for small groups in Peregrine House that can be used 24 hours

- Is there a secure place I can leave my personal property (including luggage)?
 - o Yes. We have sole use of the Alumni Lounge which will have space set aside for storage of any luggage if you are waiting for check-in or have to check-out (removing your luggage prior to the end of the workshop)
 - o The Alumni Lounge will be locked when it is not staffed (outside of the listed open hours)
- Will the workshop be environmentally conscientious?
 - o Recycling – paper and containers
 - o Garage – organic green bin
 - o Water Bottle Filling stations
 - o Food service using China plates and metal utensils
 - o Coffee/Tea and Snack service uses China cups and metal utensils
 - o Food served is sourced locally
- Will the workshop access products and services that are from Canadian sources?
 - o The college sources as many supplies locally as possible.
- What are the security plans for the workshop?
 - o Each person at the workshop will be issued a workshop badge on a lanyard
 - o The workshop guide has a section on security considerations including emergency numbers
